INR Remittance via Overseas Intermediary

Convert your Foreign Exchange in overseas country through the intermediary of your choice. Intermediary can be an Exchange House, an Overseas Bank or a Fintech company engaged in forex remittances.

Since conversion is done in the overseas country, Equitas does not play any role in currency conversion and you receive direct credit of funds in your Equitas NRE Account via international bank channels.
