All the banknotes in the denomination of ₹ 50/- issued by the Reserve Bank in the earlier series will continue to be legal tender.

ii Salient Features

Obverse (Front)

1. See through register with denominational numeral 50,
2. Denominational numeral 50 in Devnagari,
3. Portrait of Mahatma Gandhi at the centre,
4. Micro letters 'RBI', '5050', 'INDIA' and '50',
5. Windowed demetalised security thread with inscriptions '5050' and RBI,
6. Guarantee Clause, Governor's signature with Promise Clause and RBI emblem towards right of Mahatma Gandhi portrait,
7. Ashoka Pillar emblem on the right,
8. Mahatma Gandhi portrait and electrotype (50) watermarks,
9. Number panel with numerals growing from small to big on the top left side and bottom right side.

Reverse (Back)

10. Year of printing of the note on the left,
11. Swachh Bharat logo with slogan,
12. Language panel,
13. Motif of **Hampi with Chariot**,
14. Denominational numeral 50 in Devnagari.

Dimension of the banknote will be **66 mm x 135 mm**.
